## Scope and Content

The Elliott Proctor Joslin papers are the product of the personal and professional life of Dr. Elliott Proctor Joslin and his family. Included in the collection are EPJ's personal and professional correspondence, travel diaries and correspondence, and educational records including school essays, notebooks, account and patient data. The collection also contains a series of family records that include correspondence, legal documents, genealogical information, family photographs, memorabilia, and publications by Joslin's mother and aunt, as well as family wedding, anniversary and birthday invitations and announcements. Also contained in the collection are a series of correspondence and memorabilia from Joslin's service in France in World War I; awards, certificates and citations he received in his lifetime; and memorial records including clippings and correspondence following his death in 1962. Original folder titles were maintained where possible. Titles imposed by the processor are indicated by brackets.
