Scope and Content

Collection consists of over 2000 photographs collected by Dr. Elliott P. Joslin and the Joslin Diabetes Center. The collection contains Joslin family photographs as well as a substantial number of images documenting the operations and activities of the Joslin Diabetes Center, including photographs from Camp Joslin, portraits of Joslin staff, and images that capture the

research and patient care functions of the Clinic. The construction and development of the Joslin Diabetes Center building is also represented in a series of interior and exterior photographs.

The photographs are cataloged and described at the item level in a database held by the Joslin Diabetes Center. This finding aid provides the names of the folders and series into which the individual images are grouped.
